TOURISM SAVES YOU MONEY

The year of 2015 was a good one for tourism in Tennessee and Hamblen County. In late August Governor Haslam and Department of Tourist Development Commissioner Kevin Triplett announced tourism had a direct economic impact of \$18.4 billion in Tennessee for 2015. This was an increase of 3.7% for the state's second largest industry. Tourism sales tax revenue increased 7% to \$1.6 billion. All 95 counties appreciated at least \$1 million in direct economic impact with the top five (Davidson, Hamilton, Knox, Shelby, and Sevier) all seeing at least \$1 billion in direct impact. Tennessee continues to be a top 10 destination for both domestic and international travelers. In a recent study conducted by the Tennes-

see Department of Tourist Development and the Center for Sustainable Business and Development at the University of Tennessee, 99% of those visiting Tennessee stated they would visit again.

Morristown/Hamblen County is ranked 20th in the state with a direct economic impact of \$90.87 million for 2015, a 4.2% increase over 2014. Visitors to Hamblen County created \$2.04 million in local sales tax revenue and \$5.65 million in state tax revenue, up 6.7% and 9.6% respectively. Contributing to that 4.2% increase were six events the Chamber's tourism department supported financially. Those events had a direct impact of \$424,759 on the local economy and generated a 19:1 return on investment. Events must meet certain criteria for hotel room nights in order to receive financial support from the Chamber.

What do all of these figures mean for you? It means that each Hamblen County household pays \$83.60 *LESS* in local taxes and \$231.54 *LESS* is state taxes. In other words, were it not for taxes generated by tourism, each Hamblen County household would pay *\$315.15 MORE* in state and local taxes.

Many of these meetings focused not only on recruitment, but how to better train and equip our workforce and learn from best practices in workforce development around the world. These partnerships strengthen our community's competitiveness and our ability to recruit and retain our industries that employ over 25% of our population.


